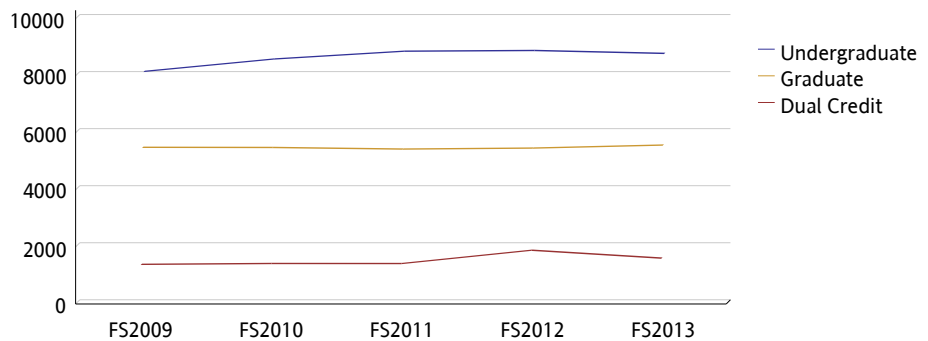

Full-Time Equivalents

Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) is defined by the Missouri Coordinating Board for Higher Education as 15 semester credit hours for undergraduate students, 12 semester credit hours for graduate students, and 15 semester credit hours for doctoral-professional law students. FTE is equivalent to headcount for doctoral-professional students in Dentistry, Medicine, and Pharmacy.

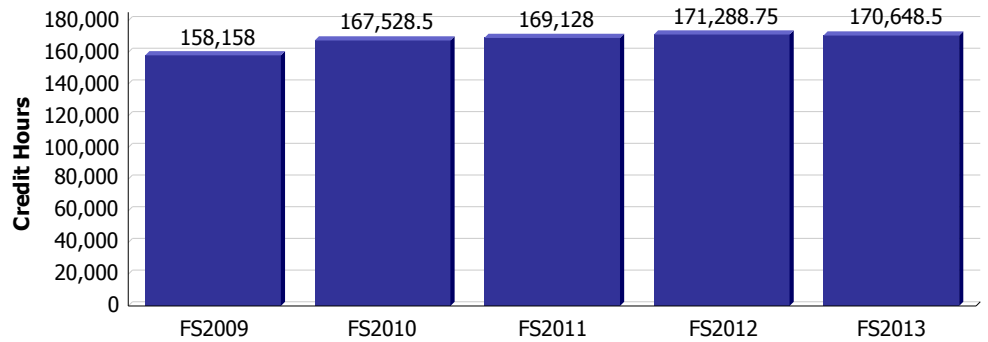

Credit Hour Production

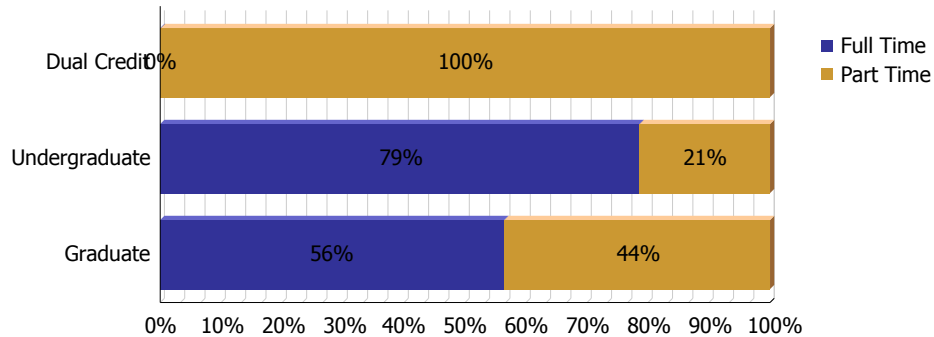
UMKC produced 170,648.5 student credit hours in FS2013, an increase of 7.9 % from FS2009



Academic Load

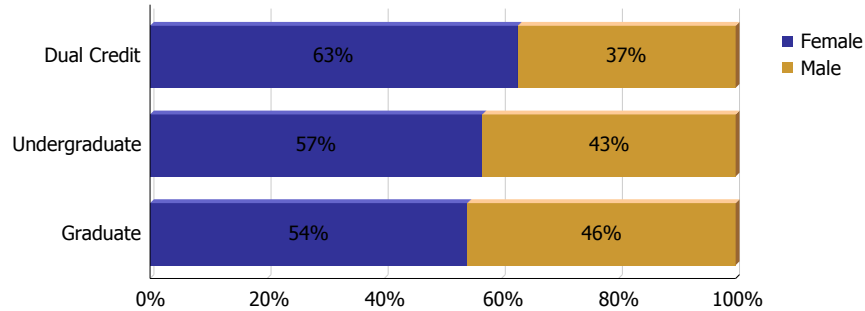
72.4 percent of UMKC on-campus students (excludes dual credit students) were enrolled full-time in FS2013, though full-time status varies by level.

For purposes of calculating full-time status, undergraduate students must be enrolled in at least 12 credits and graduate students must be enrolled in at least 9 credits. Doctoral-professional credit thresholds vary by program.



Gender

In FS2013, 44% of UMKC's on-campus students were male and 56% were female.

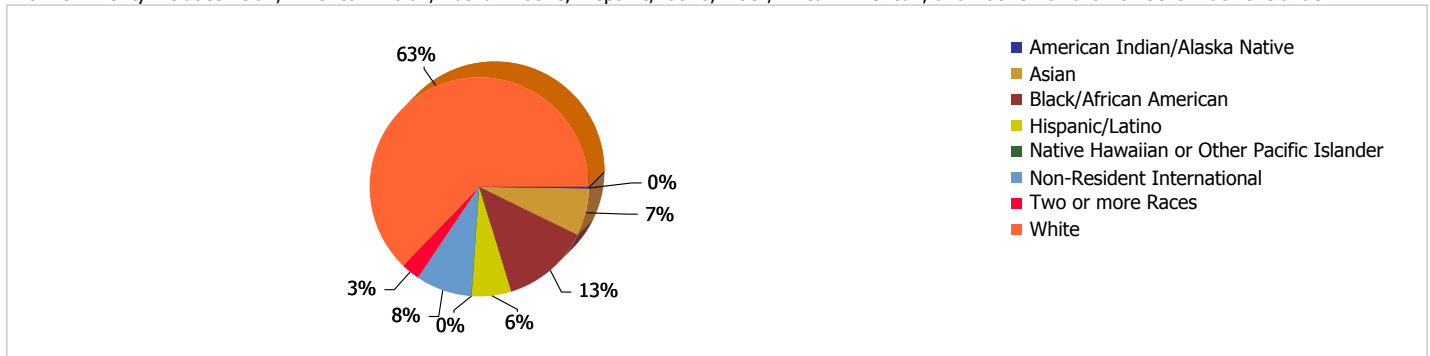


Ethnicity

UMKC's on-campus ethnic minority* population is 25%

Age

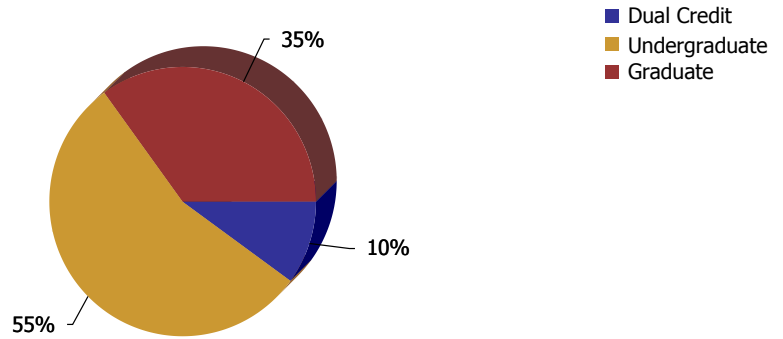
The table below shows the age distribution for UMKC students for FS2013. The average age for UMKC's total on-campus student body is 26. When dual credit high school students are included the average age is 25.

Enrollment by Career

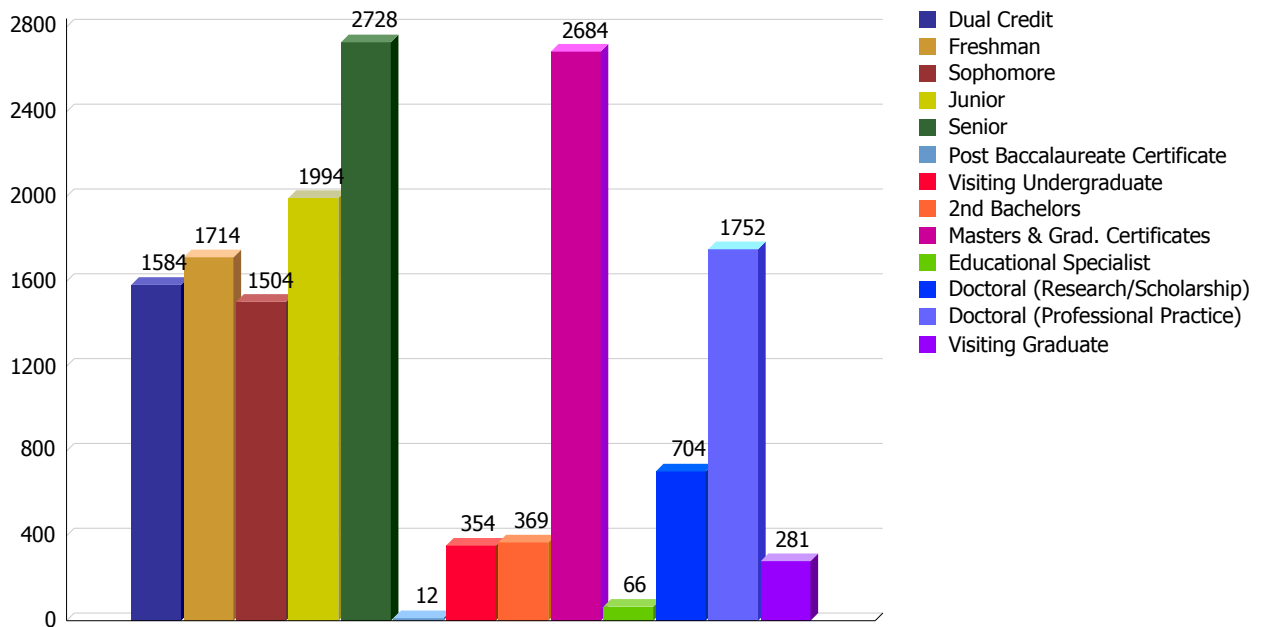
In FS2013, 10% of UMKC students were enrolled at the dual credit high school level, 55% were enrolled at the on-campus undergraduate level, 35% were enrolled at the graduate level.

When dual credit high school students are excluded, enrollments are 61% undergraduate and 39% graduate.



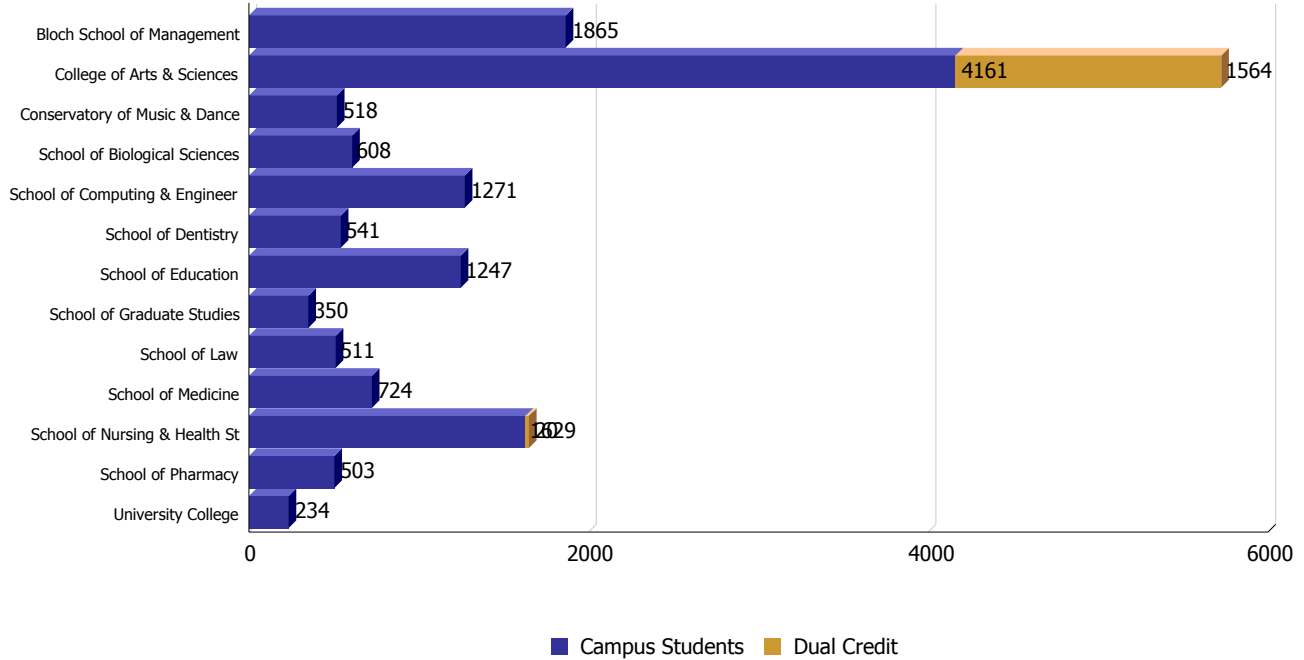
Enrollment by Academic Level

Enrollment by Academic Group

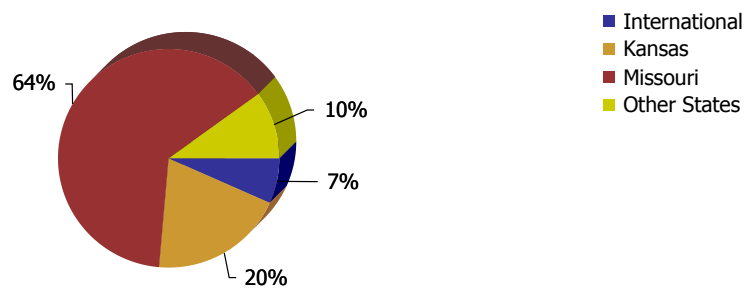
The FS2013 headcount by academic group is presented in the graph below. The largest academic group is College of Arts & Sciences.



Geographic Origin

In FS2013, Missouri residents represented 64% of the on-campus population. Another 20% were from Kansas, 10% were from other states, and 7% were international.

Note: Dual credit students are not included in the on-campus population.

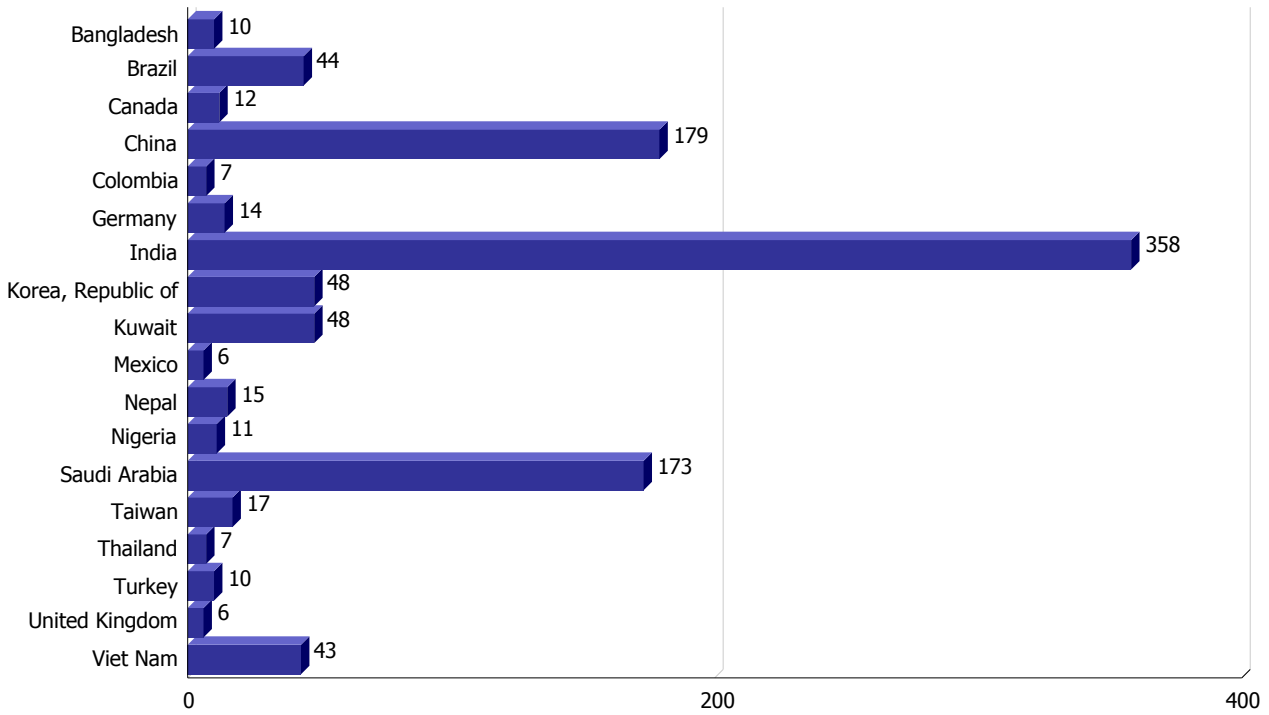


Kansas Metro Counties

In Fall 2002 UMKC began charging undergraduate students from the Kansas Metro Counties the same educational fees as Missouri students. In Fall 2010, the rate was expanded to include all non-professional graduate programs as well as additional counties encompassed within the area of Kansas City Metropolitan Statistical Area (KC-MSA).

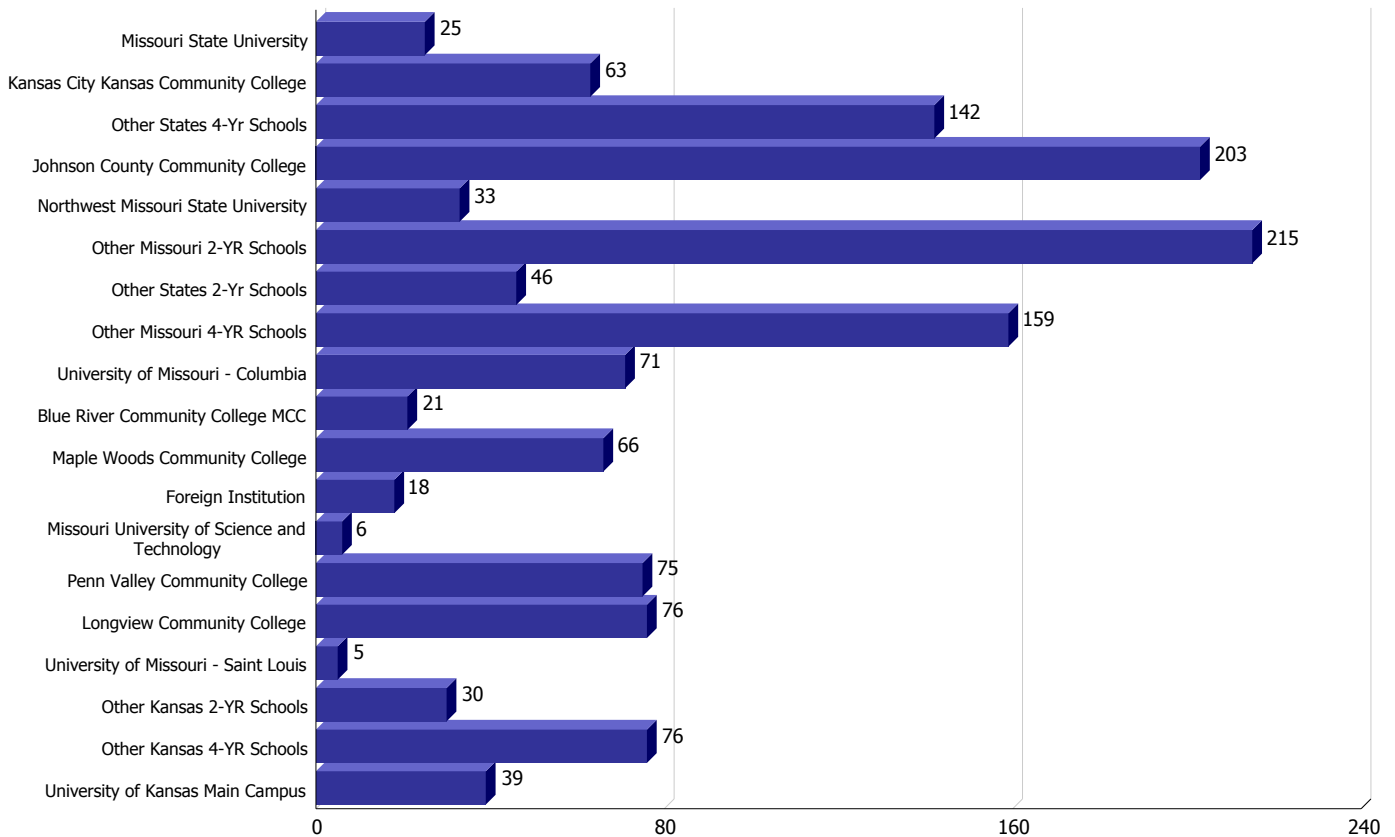

A total of 991 degree-seeking, on-campus international students enrolled at UMKC in FS2013, representing 72 countries. The figure below shows all countries represented by at least five students at UMKC.



Transfer Institutions

The majority of new undergraduates at UMKC transfer from other institutions. There were a total of 1,371 new undergraduate transfer students in FS2013. Of those, 753 transferred from Missouri colleges and universities and 618 transferred from other states and countries.

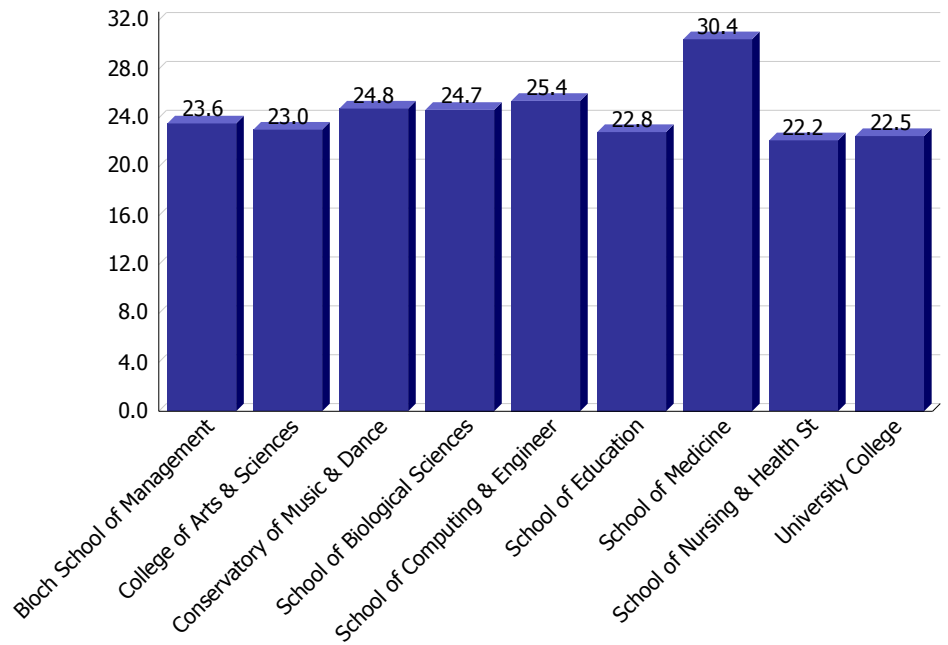


Incoming ACT Scores

A total of 1,060 first-time, full-time degree-seeking students entered in FS2013. Of these, 996 reported their ACT score to UMKC.

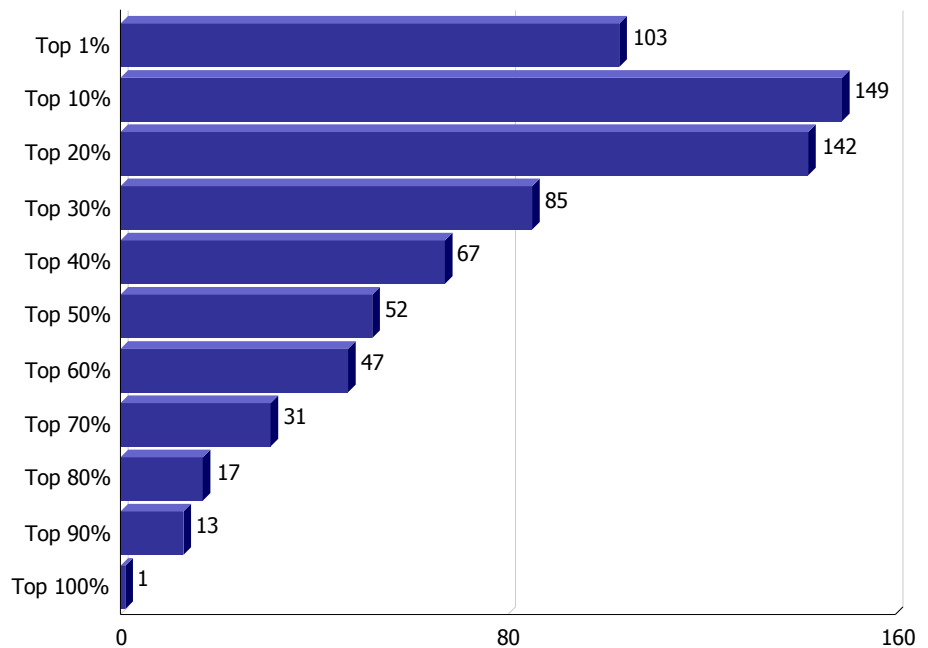
The average ACT score* for UMKC is 24

Educational & Required Fees

The 2012-2013 academic year educational and required fees are provided below. Tuition for undergraduate enrollment is \$270.10 per credit hour and graduate tuition (non-professional programs) is \$337.40 per credit hour. Graduate professional program fees are provided as a flat rate by program.
