



### Credit Hour Production


UMKC produced 176,199.5 student credit hours in FS2015%, an increase of 4.2 from FS2011




# Academic Load


74.4 percent of UMKC on-campus students (excludes dual credit students) were enrolled full-time in FS2015, though full-time status varies by level.

#### Gender






#### Ethnicity



# Enrollment by Career



When dual credit high school students are excluded, enrollments are 61% undergraduate and 39% graduate.




# Enrollment by Academic Level

The FS2015 headcount by academic group is presented in the graph below. The largest academic group is College of Arts & Sciences.





in the on-campus population.




Kansas Metro Counties


# Citizenship




# Incoming ACT Scores

A total of 1,021 first-time, full-time degree-seeking students entered in FS2015. Of these, 947 reported their ACT score to UMKC.


