

#### Full-Time Equivalents

Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) is defined by the Missouri Coordinating Board for Higher Education as 15 semester credit hours for undergraduate students, 12 semester credit hours for graduate students, and 15 semester credit hours for doctoral-professional law students. FTE is equivalent to headcount for doctoral-professional students in Dentistry, Medicine, and Pharmacy.



# Credit Hour Production


UMKC produced 172,105.5 student credit hours in FS2019, a decrease of -2.3 % from FS2015




## Academic Load

74.4 percent of UMKC on-campus students (excludes dual credit students) were enrolled full-time in FS2019, though full-time status varies by level.

For purposes of calculating full-time status, undergraduate students must be enrolled in at least 12 credits and graduate students must be enrolled in at least 9 credits. Doctoral-professional credit thresholds vary by program.








#### Ethnicity

UMKC's on-campus ethnic minority\* population is 26%

The percentages included in this figure were calculated based on the FS2019 on-campus enrollment where ethnicity is known. Ethnicity was not reported for 462 on-campus students.

The table below shows the age distribution for UMKC students for FS2019. The average age for UMKC's total on-campus student body is 25. When dual credit high school students are included the average age is 23.



## Enrollment by Career

In FS2019, 22% of UMKC students Dual Credit were enrolled at the dual credit Undergraduate 31% Graduate high school level, 47% were enrolled at the on-campus undergraduate level, 31% were enrolled at the graduate level. When dual credit high school 47% students are excluded, enrollments are 60% undergraduate and 40% 22% graduate.


#### Enrollment by Academic Level

The FS2019 headcount by academic group is presented in the graph below. The largest academic group is College of Arts & Sciences.






## Citizenship

#### Transfer Institutions

The majority of new undergraduates at UMKC transfer from other institutions. There were a total of 1,018 new undergraduate transfer students in FS2019. Of those, 514 transferred from Missouri colleges and universities and 504 transferred from other states and countries.




# Incoming ACT Scores

A total of 1,173 first-time, full-time degree-seeking students entered in FS2019. Of these, 1,069 reported their ACT score to UMKC.



## **Educational & Required Fees**

The 2019-2020 academic year educational and required fees are provided below. Tuition for undergraduate enrollment is \$294.80 per credit hour and graduate tuition (non-professional programs) is \$397.60 per credit hour. Graduate professional program fees are provided as a flat rate by program.
